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Parade Route Info:

Length = 8 city blocks. The Parade will launch promptly at 11:30am on Saturday, May 7th, 2005. We will have more info on the route as we approach the event, as we are still in negotiations with the City of Berkeley.

Free Float Building Info Packet: If you are serious about building a float contact info@thepaganalliance.org and we will mail you the packet. If you are using a vehicle, it must be marked and/or decorated to indicate that it is in the parade procession.

Television/film coverage:

Please be advised that you will be filmed and photographed by staff photographers, the media, and television news stations. If you do not wish to be filmed, simply wear a costume or mask, or come as a supportive spectator, but please do come and help to create and show the kind of world you wish to live in; Unity, Peace, and Pride.

Contingent / Float Wheel Monitors:

In the interest of safety, we are requiring that contingent monitors be designated for each group of 5 or more participants. They will march with you, and keep an eye on your safety, and keep an eye on the spacing between your group and the group in front of you. Float monitors are **REQUIRED** by The Pagan Alliance, Inc., and may double as contingent monitors. They will be on each side of the float, making sure nothing (or nobody) falls underneath the tires of the vehicles. This is for the safety of all involved.

Priority Deadline: You and/or your group receive priority in requesting performance time slots and parade placing priority.

Final Deadline: You and/or your group will be placed wherever available, and cannot request changes in the final program. reserves the right to refuse an application that may present a relevant conflict of interest with our mission statement:

The mission of the Pagan Alliance is to educate our Communities and the general public, to promote acceptance of our faiths and traditions, to connect our Communities, and to celebrate our spiritual diversity.

Further, The Pagan Alliance reserves the right to remove any person or unit from the staging area, or the parade, who is, in its sole discretion and opinion, a hindrance to the safety or progress of the parade; or who places other participants or spectators in physical danger, or whose participation is inconsistent with the purposes and objectives of the event as set forth above.

Priority Deadline: March 22, 2005. Final Deadline: April 22, 2005. All performances are subject to approval by the parade committee in order to maintain safety and parade regulations. Please sign, date, and return this form by the deadline date in order to be included in parade program. This event will be covered by the media, so please make sure that the members of your troupe are advised of this. Also, due to insurance reasons, weapons and pyrotechnics are not allowed unless your troupe wishes to extend the parade insurance policy.

Contract Terms and Hold Harmless Agreement

General - Participants of the parade are to act in accordance with the rules and laws that govern the City of Berkeley. We are asking that you and your contingent be conscious of the fact that we, The Pagan Alliance, are trying to educate the public about the beautiful and spiritual nature of our diverse communities. If you think you may be acting in an offensive manner to the other communities that are participating in this Celebration, you probably are. Please be conscious of this request. We have worked very hard to be inclusive of many traditions, and do not wish to alienate others because we wish to "shock" our spectators. Thank you for your support in this matter.

Floats - At no time and for no reason may anyone jump on and off a float once it is on the parade route. Only in cases of medical emergency may passengers disembark from a float, and in that event, only when the float has come to a complete and total stop. All vehicles / bicycles/ floats must be approved before they are placed in the line up, or they will be removed from the site.

In consideration of the acceptance of this application and permission to participate as a entrant in the 2005 Pagan Festival, I, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby release, waive, and forever discharge The Pagan Alliance, The City of Berkeley, The Berkeley Police, the Chief of police, the Berkeley City Council and its members, and all other associations, sanctioning bodies and sponsoring companies, and all of their respective agents, officials, servants, contractors, representatives, elected and appointed officials, successors and assigns OF AND FROM ALL claims, demands, costs, expenses, actions and causes of action, whether in law or equity, in respect of death, injury, loss, or damage to my person or property HOWSOEVER CAUSED, arising or to arise by reason of my participation in the said event, whether as a vendor, spectator, participant, author, whether prior to, during or subsequent to the event, AND NOTWITHSTANDING that the same may have been contributed to, or occasioned by the negligence of any of the aforesaid. FURTHER HERBEY UNDERTAKE TO HOLD AND SAVE HARMLESS AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY all of the aforesaid from and against and all liability incurred by any or all of them as a result of, or in any way connected with my participation in said event.
